The BASIC (Basic Assessment and Support in Intensive Care) course is a two-day course consisting of lectures, skill stations and tutorials taught by Intensive Care specialists, with an emphasis on a practical approach to management of critically ill patients.

Key topics covered include

- (a) Recognition of the critically ill patient
- (b) Resuscitation and Stabilisation
- (c) Mechanical ventilation
- (d) Haemodynamic monitoring and support
- (e) Transport of the critically ill patient
- (f) Metabolic and Blood Gas analysis
