### Kate Flynn Medal

The Kate Flynn Medal 2020 will take place as part of the National Intensive Care COVID Research & Scientific Conference on 5th September 2020. This meeting takes place the day after the 2-day charity cycle **ICU 4 U** and is designed to focus on local expertise and knowledge gained over the COVID pandemic era thus far.

As per usual Kate Flynn criteria, applications are invited for submission of any presentations of interesting cases or case series related to Intensive Care Medicine. Given the uniqueness of the last few months, presentations of clinical research (not necessarily case-based) related to Covid-19 will also be considered for presentation.

This meeting will be a Webinar, and thus individuals will present remotely online in the form of a PowerPoint presentation. Individuals whose work may not be selected for live presentations will be invited to record their work in a Podcast form for a wider audience. There will be a prize/medal for this category as well. More details will follow.

#### Guidelines for Abstract Submission:

The presenter should submit abstracts as a word document—Max 250 words and structured as background, case presentation, and conclusion.

Abstracts may include relevant case reports or case series. Cases should be original, including why the case should be reported, and the essential implications or message for the Intensive Care Community.
